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Dear Foehs,

Well first of all, I have been carrying around this birthday card for the longest time - no stamp, & with the post office closed in the afternoon hrs & those being my only time free, I've been taking this card with me everywhere - now, I decided I might as well enclose a letter & completely fill you in.

Today is Sunday morning & I'm at the Horowitz's - Tovis out - & I slept till 11:30!!! Can you imagine?! That's the latest I've slept since America - all my tiredness came through in one shot. It's very good tho, now I feel excellent & I'm doubly happy because there is no class today - or all week because tomorrow 6:00 AM we are going to Shenai!!!!

I've really missed Tijulim this year, I enjoy them so much, & this one is a 4-day trip to Sinai with the best guide (Madrich) in the country - he's the one who took us on all those crazy great Tijulim last year, & altho I went to Sinai last year & had a fantastic time, it wasn't with Dor Bagan, so this one is bound to be really good. We're spending 4 days in Sinai - 3 nights: one in Abu-Rodees where they have all the oil wells, etc. One in Santa-Caterina which is a monastery COMPLETELY isolated way up on some mountain, & that night we're gonna get up at

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3:00 A.M. we wake up to the top of some other mts
which according to Bedouin tradition is Har Sinai
& then will watch the sunrise, & dawn. The
third night will be spending in Sharm el-Sheikh
which will be beautiful - on the beach - & then
Thursday we return back to Jerusalem. It
should be really fantastic & I'm looking forward
to this year I won't forget my camera (last year it
broke)

I just had a real long talk with Ari (Tova's
19-yr old brother) & we got talking about Tiyulim
& all the different adventures his dad, & his
dad (& really hasn't had many - its kinda
blah going on an organized tiyul with
50 other kids). He's gone by himself with one
or two other friends to such great places & they
did such great things. Eli, especially, has gone to
the most fantastic places - he used to go by
himself to these isolated BEAUTIFUL places & spend
days by himself hiking around & climbing. Ari
just told me that Eli used to take 2 pistols (he
was in the army) & he would go up to the Abelan
& there its most beautiful but very dangerous.
Now I have to ask him - how many of these

so anyway, we have to go shopping for food
(tuna fish for 4 days) etc & I have to get hold of a

sleeping bag & a knapsack. Till ya man when I get back!

Nothing much new has happened recently. I've been working - & by the way, since my last letter I feel 100% to ~~so~~ better. Just one of those blue days I guess.

Ech! I just heard about the fire-fight in Viet-Nam. I hope I didn't understand the news - but from what I THINK they said, it would seem that the Viet-Cong broke the cease-fire, they attacked 136 times & are laughing at the American. I'd wait till 6:30 (7:30) to hear the Eng. news to verify, but it's so disappointing & disheartening. so disheartening. I guess we just have to each work on his own personal self, & pray that people will gain some degree of understanding & conception of the whole world, of what's going on, & then thru this generality - & will range looking & understanding all this violence & killing, all these horrendous gages will stop. It's so disappointing.

High. So how's everything there? Dad, how is your diet, smoking? How are the plans going for you guys to come Rosh Hashana time? I know? How's Star & Jean? Ryan? Ya know it's the FUNNIEST thing about that letter didn't I tell you? I wrote



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at - all 20 pages a masterpiece - & on the way to mail it, I lost it!! Apparently, someone found it & put a stamp on it & mailed it - isn't that fantastic? And it was heavy enough to take 2 or maybe 3 overseas stamps - isn't that nice?? Only in Israel. So that accounts, I guess for the beat up envelope etc. Who knows where I left it - in some gutter or something - until someone found it - wow. So tell him I deserve an answer, & not to be like me, but sooner than 7 months.

What did you do on your birthday Ma? Have a nice time? Happy Hanukkah?? Now all the Gibbets - Suji & Gary? Linda & Ronnie?

What's the weather like? Here it's the craggiest year they've had in a long time. No rain, & all the crops are dying, & either a FREEZING cold - very bad. And it's shmita year, which is the 7th year during which you're not supposed to grow & sell crops (long to explain - I'll do it later), so vegetables are VERY expensive, & I hate to say from the Arabs.

Tell nothing more to say, really, I'll write more often this week - have a nice week - & COME FOR RASH HASHANAH * Love Deb
